- Class 1 Bortle Sky: Excellent dark sky site.
- Minimal Light Pollution: Most islands and beaches are remote, with little artificial lighting.
- Pristine Atmosphere: Surrounded by the Bay of Bengal and Andaman Sea, the skies are free from haze and industrial smog.
- **Open Horizons:** Wide beaches and elevated viewpoints provide uninterrupted 180°–360° views of the night sky.

TIPS FOR ECO-FRIENDLY STARGAZING

- Carry a red torch/low light lamp (doesn't disturb night vision or wildlife).
- Avoid loud sounds—many stargazing spots are also turtle nesting beaches.
- Carry a mat or reclining chair for comfortable skywatching.
- Pair stargazing with night kayaking in bioluminescent waters (Swaraj & Shaheed Dweep)
 —a magical double experience.

BEST WINDOW TO GAZE

- November to March → Clear skies, low. humidity, calm seas.
- New Moon Nights → Darkest skies, best for spotting the Milky Way.
- Post-sunset till midnight > Peak viewing hours before moisture clouds form.
