# Be A Responsible Angler

- Carry valid e-permits for every sailing.
- Please check emergency contacts (Police, Coast Guard, MRCC, Medical, Crew, Do's & Don'ts) are clearly displayed on board.
- Use only permitted gear.
- Respect local communities and traditional fishing grounds.
- Follow safety and weather instructions from authorities.
- Only carry back 2 fish (total  $\leq 10$  kg) per trip.
- Release protected species caught accidentally (as per Wildlife Act).
- Handle and release fish carefully, unharmed.
- Assist other boats/fishers in distress.
- Do not dispose off garbage in the seas.

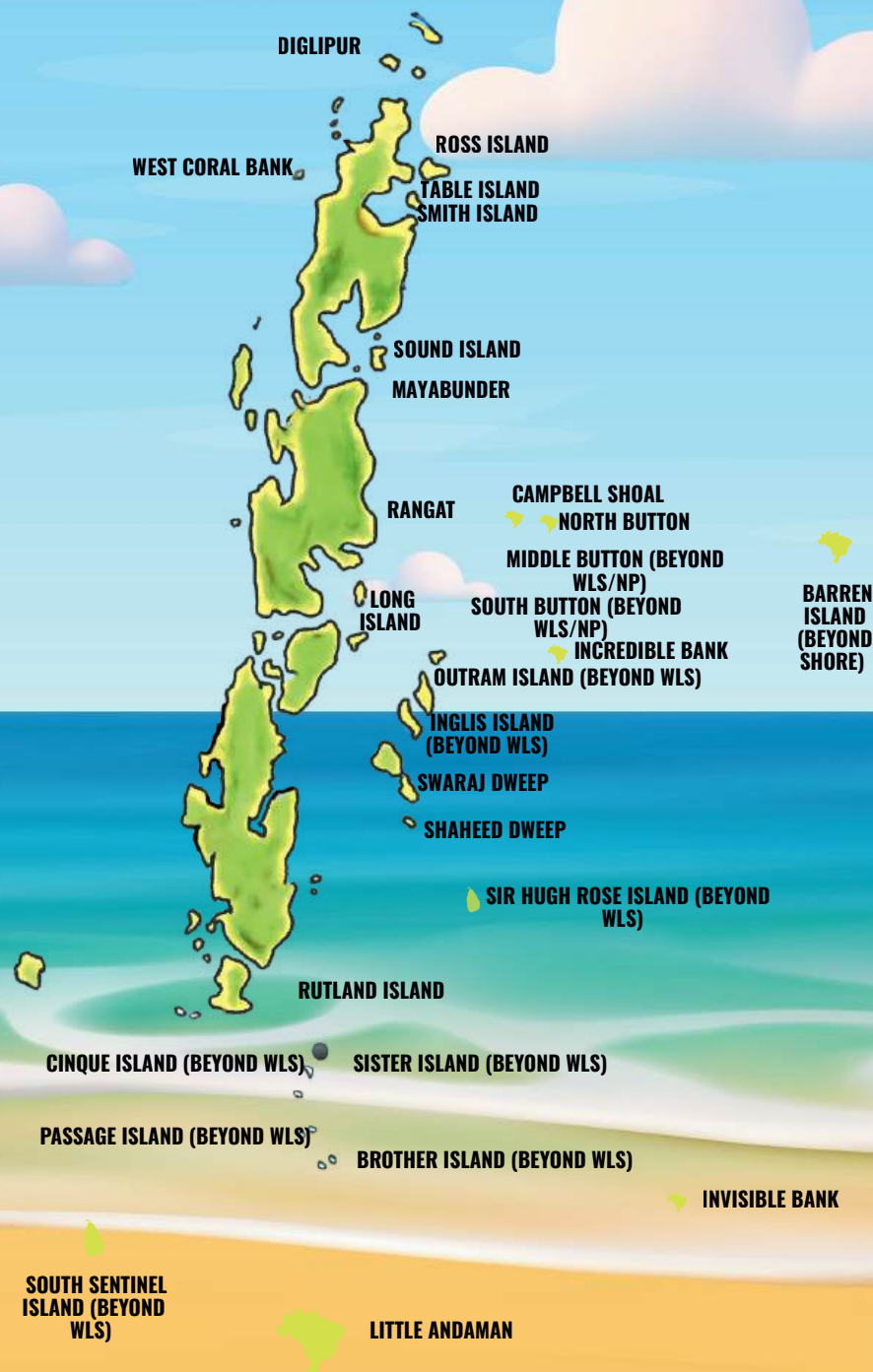

## Keep it Clean. Keep it Kind.

- Do not fish in restricted / protected marine areas.
- Do not use live bait, nets, or harmful materials.
- Do not disturb / damage coral reefs or habitats.
- Do not litter or discard lines/hooks at sea.
- Do not anchor near islands, parks, or sanctuaries.
- Stay onboard & do not disembark without permission.
- Do not exceed vessel's passenger capacity.
- Do not carry UAVs, contraband, or explosives onboard.
- Do not photograph protected species.
- Use the vessel only for fishing activities.
- No operation within 3 nm from nearest Port/ Jetty of Zone-A.
- Speed limit of 10 knots near coral reef/ restricted areas whenever innocent passage is given by Authorities.
