You need to provide a title and abstract (250 words maximum) for a 10 minute paper (unless otherwise specified), your name and institutional affiliation (if any). Please make sure the title is concise and reflects the contents of the paper because the title is what appears online, in social media and in the printed programme.

1. Font size: 12-point throughout
2. Justification: Left margin only, no indentations
3. Line spacing: Text should be single spaced
4. Abstract text: maximum of 250 words

No citations/quotes to be included in abstracts
