Star Gazing Sites in Andaman Islands:

- ★ Chidiya Tapu – Clear skies and less light pollution.
- ★ Radhanagar Beach (Swaraj Dweep) – Open beach with wide night sky views.
- ★ Lalaji Bay (Long Island) – Secluded and dark surroundings.
- ★ Diglipur (North Andaman) – Remote area ideal for Milky Way viewing.
- ★ Little Andaman (Hut Bay) – Quiet beaches with minimal artificial light.

Popular Scuba Diving Sites in Andaman:

- Near Chidiyatapu: Fish Point, Sur Mandi, Che Naila
- Swaraj dweep (Havelock): Dixons Pinnacle, Jackson Bar, Lighthouse, Slope, Wall, Jonny Gorge
- Shaheed Dweep (Neil): Fishgate, Margherita, K Rock
- Shipwrecks: Incheithi (Swaraj Dweep), Sophie Marie (Chidiyatapu), North Bay Wreck, MV Mars

Heritage, Geo-Heritage and Museums Places in Andaman:

- Cellular Jail – Historic colonial prison and national memorial.
- Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island – Ruins of British administrative settlement.
- Chatham Saw Mill – Historic sawmill with museum.
- Anthropological Museum – Tribal culture exhibits.
- Samudrika Naval Marine Museum – Marine life and island history displays.
- Baratang Limestone Caves – Natural limestone formations (geo-heritage).
- Mud Volcano – Rare geological mud eruption site.
- Barren Island – India's only active volcano (geo-heritage).

Bird Watching Sites in Andaman:

- Saddle Peak National Park – Dense forests ideal for spotting endemic Andaman birds.
- Munda Pahad – Coastal forest trails good for early-morning bird sightings.
- Shoal Bay 19 – Wetland and coastal habitat attracting migratory birds.
- Sliplight Wetlands – Mangrove and wetland ecosystem rich in birdlife.
- Khudirampur Creek – Quiet mangrove creeks ideal for bird observation.
- Baratang Limestone Caves – Surrounding forests host various forest bird species.

Trekking Sites in Andaman

- Saddle Peak – Highest peak trek with panoramic island views.
- Mount Manipur – Forest trails and scenic viewpoints.
- Munda Pahad – Coastal trek with sunset views.
- Kalangang Trails – Plantation and forest trekking routes.
- Panchwati Hills – Short treks through lush green hills and waterfalls.



Ross & Smith Islands

Ross & Smith Islands, in North Andaman, are linked by a low tide sandbar, featuring white beaches, clear waters, and great snorkeling.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param (Port Blair) - Ferry to South Andam (via Port Blair/Chidiyatapu) - Walk across the natural sandbar to Ross Island.

Saddle Peak

Saddle Peak, located in North Andaman, is the highest point in the Andaman Islands, known for trekking trails, dense tropical forests, and panoramic views of the surrounding islands and sea.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param (Port Blair) - Diglipur (By road/ferry) - Trek to Saddle Peak National Park - Trek to Saddle Peak.

Kalipur Beach

Kalipur Beach is a quiet beach near Diglipur, known for its black sand, scenic views, and excellent surf conditions.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param (Port Blair) - Diglipur (By road/ferry) - Trek to Kalipur Beach.

Rampur Beach

Rampur Beach in Diglipur, North Andaman, is a quiet and scenic beach, ideal for peaceful walks and relaxation away from crowds.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param (Port Blair) - Diglipur (By road/ferry) - Govt Bus/Taxi/Auto/Bus to Rampur Beach.

Karmatang Beach

Karmatang Beach in North Andaman is known for its long sandy shores, peaceful surroundings, and excellent surfing conditions.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param (Maulabunder) - Govt Bus/Taxi/Auto to Karmatang Beach - Auto to Mangrove Watch Tower.

Dhani Nallah

Dhani Nallah Beach in Rangit is known for its scenic mangrove forest, peaceful surroundings, and excellent surfing conditions.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Rangit (By road & Andaman Trek Road or by ferry) - Govt Bus/Taxi/Auto from Rangit town (about 20 km) - Dhani Nallah Beach.

Amkunj Beach

Amkunj Beach is a beautiful beach in Rangit, North Andaman, known for its clear waters and scenic views.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param (Port Blair) - Ferry to Rangit - Trek to Amkunj Beach.

Lalaji Bay Beach

Lalaji Bay Beach is known for its beautiful mangrove forest and peaceful surroundings, making it ideal for relaxation and nature walks.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param (Port Blair) - Ferry to Long Island - Trek to Lalaji Bay Beach.

Barren Island

Barren Island is India's only active volcano, located in the Andaman Sea, and is known for its volcanic landscape and rich marine life. The Government operates a Barren Island cruise every 15 days for sightseeing around Barren Island.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Chortoned Island / Barren Island vessel - Barren Island (viewing trip only).

Kalapatthar Beach

Kalapatthar Beach, located on Swaraj Dweep, is known for its black sand, clear blue waters, and peaceful surroundings. It is an ideal spot for relaxing, snorkeling, and enjoying water sports.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Ferry to Swaraj Dweep - Trek to Kalapatthar Beach.

Radhanagar Beach

Radhanagar Beach is a world-famous beach known for its white sands, blue waters, and beautiful sunsets. It is also a Blue Flag certified beach, recognized for international standards of cleanliness and environmental management.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Havelock (Jerry) - Taxicab - Radhanagar Beach.

Cellular Jail

Cellular Jail, located in Port Blair, is a historic colonial prison built by the British to imprison anti-colonial fighters. Today, it stands as a national monument preserving their sacrifice.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Govt Bus/Auto leads to Cellular Jail.

Viper Island

Viper Island is a historic island near Sri Vijaya Param known for the ruins of an old British jail and gallows, offering scenic views and glimpses of the island's colonial past.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Boat from Phoenix Bay Jetty - Viper Island.

Chidiya Tapu

Known as the 'Peak of the East' during the British era, it was abandoned in the 1950s following an earthquake and the Japanese occupation. Visiting and enjoying the isolation of the island is a unique experience. It is a quiet, serene, and scenic spot, known for its clear skies, minimal light pollution, and beautiful views of stars and the Milky Way, making it an ideal spot for peaceful night sky observation.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Govt Bus/Taxi/Auto - Chidiya Tapu.

Wandoor Beach

Wandoor Beach, near Sri Vijaya Param, is known for its white sands, clear waters, and scenic views. It is an ideal spot for relaxing, sunbathing, and enjoying water sports.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Havelock - Wandoor Beach (By road, 10 km).

Jolly Buoy Island

Jolly Buoy Island in Andaman is a protected island, known for its white sands, clear waters, and scenic views. It is a part of the Andaman Cellular Jail National Park.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Ferry/Boat from Havelock Jetty - Jolly Buoy Island (only view only on sunset trip).

Chidiya Tapu

Known as the 'Peak of the East' during the British era, it was abandoned in the 1950s following an earthquake and the Japanese occupation. Visiting and enjoying the isolation of the island is a unique experience. It is a quiet, serene, and scenic spot, known for its clear skies, minimal light pollution, and beautiful views of stars and the Milky Way, making it an ideal spot for peaceful night sky observation.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Govt Bus/Taxi/Auto - Chidiya Tapu.

Butler Bay Beach

Butler Bay Beach is a beautiful beach in North Andaman, known for its clear waters and scenic views.

How to go:
Sri Vijaya Param - Govt Bus/Taxi/Auto - Butler Bay Beach.

Hut Bay Beach

Star Gazing in Hut Bay (Little Andaman) offers clear night skies, minimal light pollution, and beautiful views of stars and the Milky Way, making it an ideal spot for peaceful night sky observation.

Light House

The Little Andaman Lighthouse is an important coastal landmark guiding ships through the surrounding waters. It offers scenic views of the sea and nearby coastline and is known as a peaceful spot for photography and sightseeing.
